

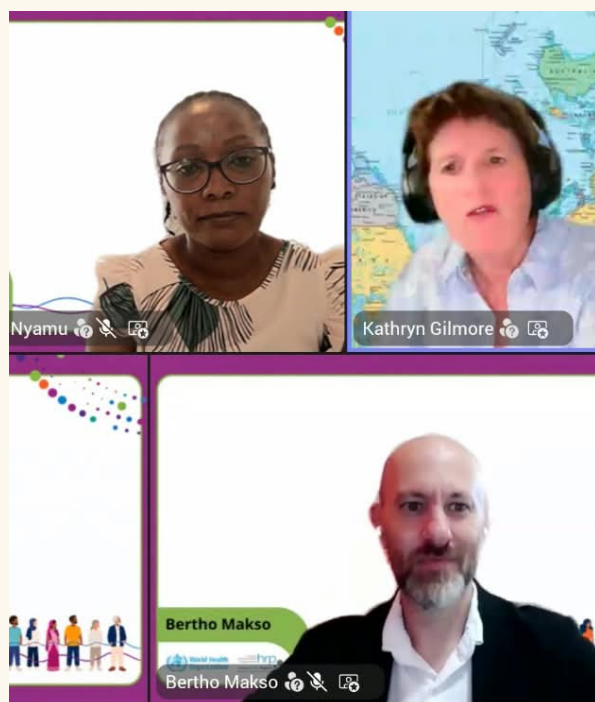

TURNING KNOWLEDGE INTO PROGRESS IN REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH



"The World Health Organization (WHO) organised a Flagship Discussion on 2 September 2026, from 5:30 PM to 7:00 PM, to mark the launch of World Sexual and Reproductive Health Month 2026. The discussion centred on the theme "Evidence to Impact: The Past, Present and Future of Research and Progress in Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights," bringing attention to the role of research and evidence in advancing sexual and reproductive health and rights. Our committee members voluntarily participated in this flagship discussion

The session brought together experts from different fields to reflect on the progress achieved through research, the challenges in transforming evidence into effective action, and the priorities that will shape the future of sexual and reproductive health and rights.
